

NEW GRADUATES AND LIS STUDENTS **ENTER TO WIN A TRAVEL BURSARY TO NLS6**



The New Generation Advisory Committee (NGAC) is pleased to offer the chance to win a bursary towards part of your travel and/or accommodation costs to attend the ALIA 6th New Librarians Symposium (NLS6), held in Brisbane from 9-12 February 2013.

As part of the ALIA Board of Directors and NGAC's commitment to providing opportunities for professional development, this offer is designed to enable new graduate ALIA Associate member(s) or student member(s) currently undertaking an ALIA-recognised tertiary LIS course **who would not otherwise receive funding from their organisation** the chance to attend this conference.

How to enter - Digital storytelling

Using the symposium themes of **'be different'** tell us how a bursary will help you to achieve this: in any way, shape or form - with reference to one or more of the sub themes; inspire, imagine, create, lead, climb, leap. This could also include ways in which, **"being different"** will contribute to the profession.

Use your imagination - there is no limit to the way the application can be entered.

Ways to enter could include one of the following a written application, video, blog post, storify, pinterest, a facebook page, storybird, youtube, book spine poetry (or regular poems!) etc.....

Entry Requirements:

Applicants must:

- 1 Complete the application form below, including a statement of up to 50 words to support your application.
2. Be a personal or student member of ALIA.
3. Have no more than five (5) years since graduation from an [ALIA-recognised LIS course](#).
4. Use freely accessible media/hosting (eg. no payment required to view your entry)
5. Ensure audio/visual entries do not exceed 2 minutes playing time.

Entries will be judged against the following criteria:

A panel made up of the NGAC chair, NGG member and the ALIAWest Chair will decide the successful applicants using the following criteria:

- How will attending NLS6 enhance your career development? (points/10)
- What contribution will you make to the wider LIS sector as a result of attending this event? (points/10)
- Engagement with the theme of “be different” (points/5)
- Creative/innovative use of resources available (points/5)

- No late applications will be accepted.
- Entry is open to anyone including those wishing to attend who are not presenting during the symposium - except members of the NLS6 organising committee and NGAC

- The winning applicant(s) will be required to create 2 (two) blog posts for the NLS6 blog, before and after the symposium.

- This offer is for part of accommodation and travel costs only. Any and all other expenses, including leave, event registration, and remaining accommodation and travel costs will be the responsibility of the applicant.
